This entire threat seems very misleading....forget the 30 most prestigious wines of Bordeaux and there are at least 100-150 wines under \$50...many under \$35...even with our pathetically weak dollar,they represent some of the finest wine values in the world....for both quality and longevity....there are so many very good wines emerging from Bordeaux from low pedigree AOCs that are actually brilliant wines....and sell for a song....just check out the better Fronsacs,Cotes de Castillons,Lalande de Pomerols,and the southern Medoc wines from a small but very high quality group of passionate young producers "Biturica"...names such as Senejac,Gironville,Milles-Rose,Cambon La Pelouse,and Belle-Vue.....few of any of the above wines cost more than \$25 ...and I doubt anyone can find wines of such elegance,complexity,and longevity from caberet sauvignon, cabernet franc,and merlot anywhere else at this price point or quality

level....
